

## **Rules for Contributions to Corporate Political Action Committees in Tennessee December 2003**

### **What is Prohibited?**

The contribution of corporate dollars to PACs is prohibited.

*For example: Mr. Joe Citizen, president of ABC Manufacturing, Inc. may not use his corporate credit card to pay for his participation at a PAC-sponsored golf tournament.*

### **What is Allowed?**

Corporate PAC dollars may be contributed as PAC-to-PAC transfers.

- There are no limits on the amount of PAC-to-PAC transfers. There are no limits on when and how often contributions these may be made.

*For example: ABC Manufacturing, Inc., may make a PAC-to-PAC transfer to the Tennessee Chamber PAC of \$5,000 in January and May of the same year.*

Personal contributions are allowed.

- There are no limits on the amount of personal contributions to a corporate PAC. There are no limits on when and how often these contributions may be made.

*For example: Mr. Joe Citizen, president of ABC Manufacturing, Inc. may donate \$2,500 to the Tennessee Chamber PAC in January and May of the same year using a personal credit card or personal check.*
