



To Vote in Tennessee:

- 1. You must be a U.S. citizen and be at least 18 years of age by Election Day. You must be a state resident and have never been convicted of a felony.**
- 2. You must register to vote at least 30 days before the Election Day.**
- 3. Complete a Voter Registration Form and return it in person or by mail to your County Election Commission.**
 - If you register to vote by mail, you must vote in person the first time you vote.
 - You may not register to vote on-line or by e-mail.
 - If you have moved or changed names and are already registered to vote, you must notify your County Election Commission 30 days before the election.
- 4. Get to the polls on Election Day!**

Remember: If you are registered to vote, you may vote early in Tennessee. Check with your County Election Commission for locations in your community.

Remember: If you are eligible and want to vote by absentee ballot, contact your County Election Commission for an application.
